FEES CHARGEABLE FOR LEGAL PUBLICATIONS

10:02:02:01. (Effective January 1, 2022) Maximum fees chargeable. If a fee is not otherwise prescribed by statute for a legal publication of anything required or allowed by law, the maximum fee that may be charged for the publication, except as provided in § 10:02:02:02, is as follows:

Rate Per Line, First Insertion Per Column

SIZE OF TYPE

11 PICAS

6 points	43.96 <u>46.16</u> cents
8 points	33.76 <u>35.45</u> cents
9 points	29.89 <u>31.38</u> cents

If column widths vary, the line rate shall be adjusted on a percentage of space used. Tabular matter with one justification shall be charged for at one and one-half times the rates set in this section and tabular matter with two justifications or more at twice the rates.

If a fee is not otherwise prescribed by statute for a legal publication of anything required or allowed by law and that publication is made in a legal newspaper with a paid circulation of 9,000 or more, the maximum fee that may be charged for the publication is as follows:

20,000 - 29,999	6.23 <u>6.54</u>
30,000 - 39,999	6.54 <u>6.87</u>
